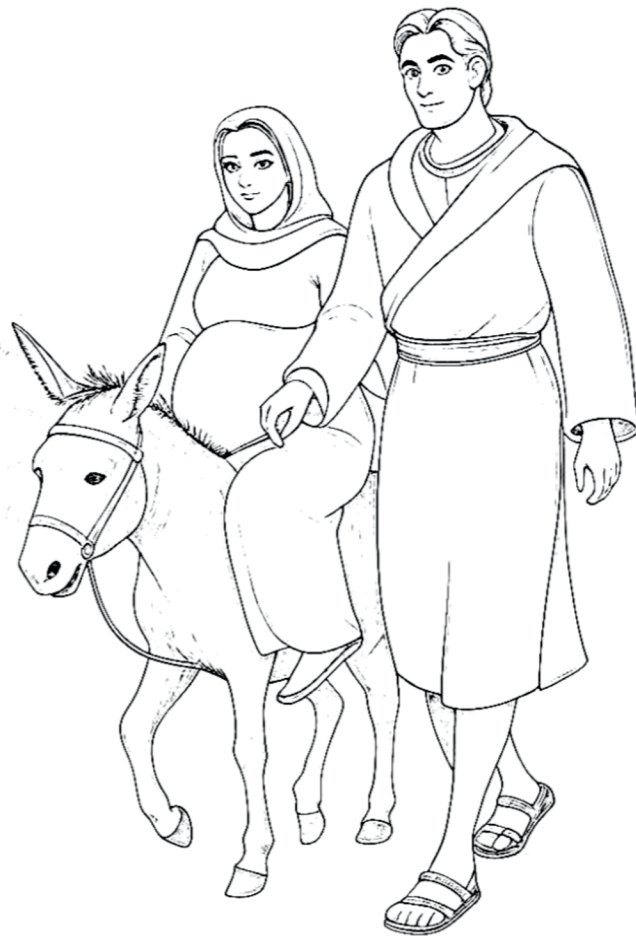

Color the star, and the angels singing!

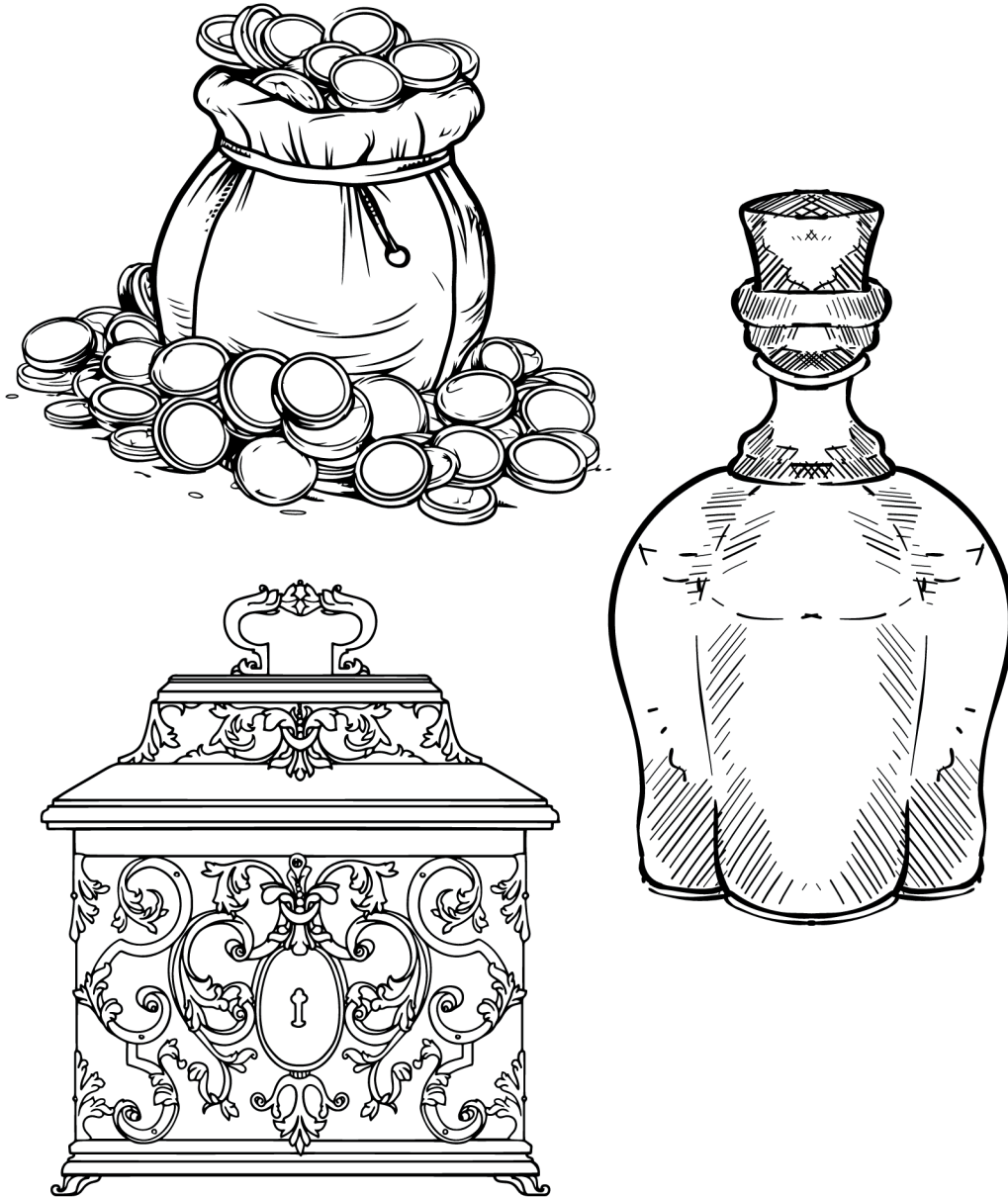
In the sky above, a bright and shining star had appeared. It guided the Wise Men to the stable to honor the Savior that was born.
