

Jesus looked up to His Father in heaven and gave thanks for the food in prayer. Then Jesus began to break the loaves of bread and the fish into pieces.

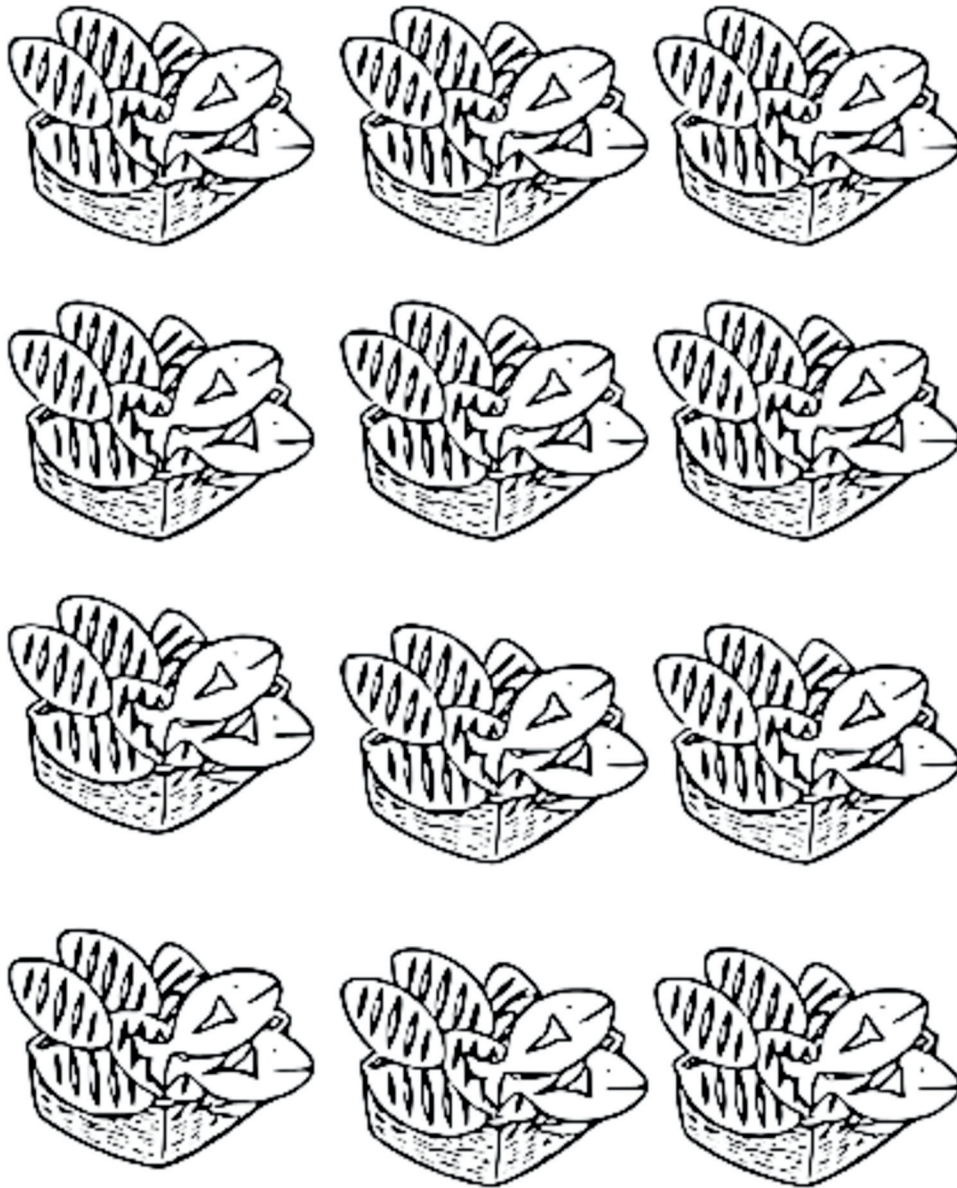
Then a miracle happened! The small amount of bread and fish multiplied in Jesus' hands.
