God said to build a big boat, called an Ark, to save some animals and Noah's family.




Color Noah listening to God!

Noah wanted people to be saved but they would not listen.


Noah spent many, many years building the Ark before it was all done. God told Noah to take his family into the Ark with him. God also gave him instructions on saving the animals.

As the days went by, the animals started to arrive. Some animals by two and some animals by seven, they came trotting and waddling.


Lions and lambs, elephants and emus, and even penguins and peacocks! It was time for everyone to get into the Ark!

Color the dove and the rainbow!


Noah and his family thanked God for keeping them safe and for the beautiful world that lay before them.
