Once upon a time, in the land of Judea, the perfect Son of God called Jesus, was teaching people about forgiveness and kindness.

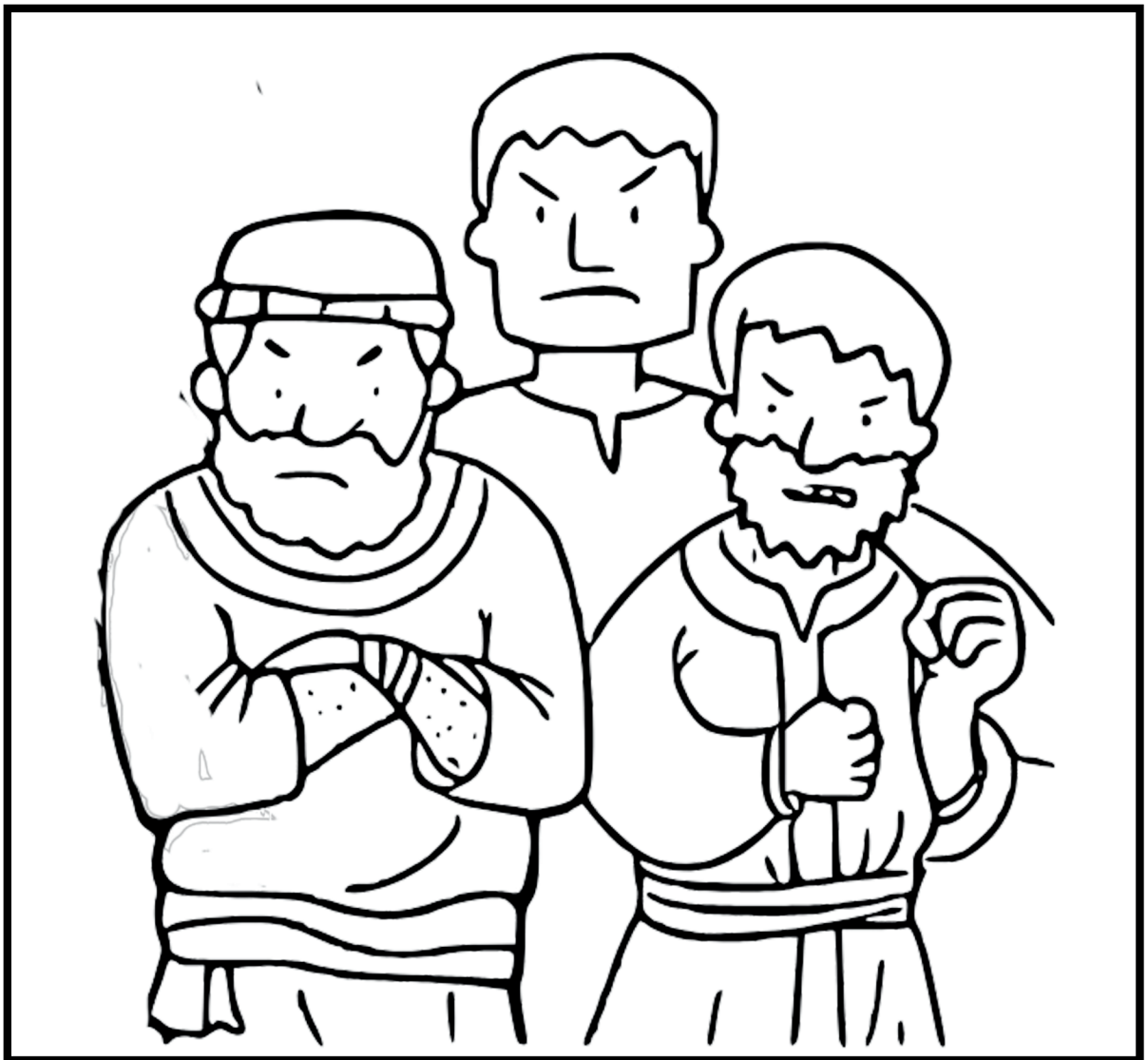
People traveled far and wide to listen to His wisdom and be healed by His words or His touch. Jesus loved the people.

Color the angry Roman men!

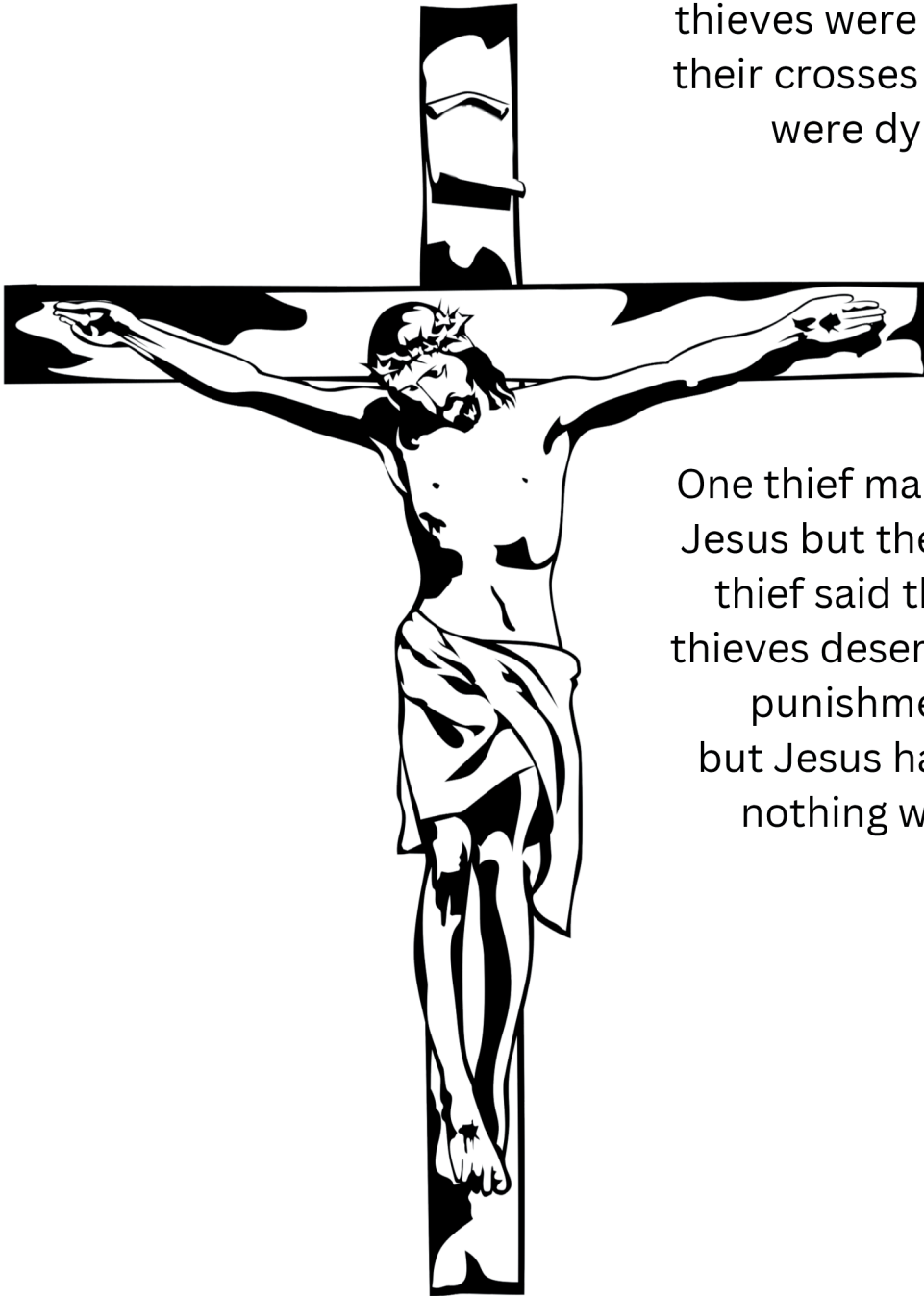


The Roman leaders were afraid they would lose their power if too many people followed Jesus instead of them.

were dying.

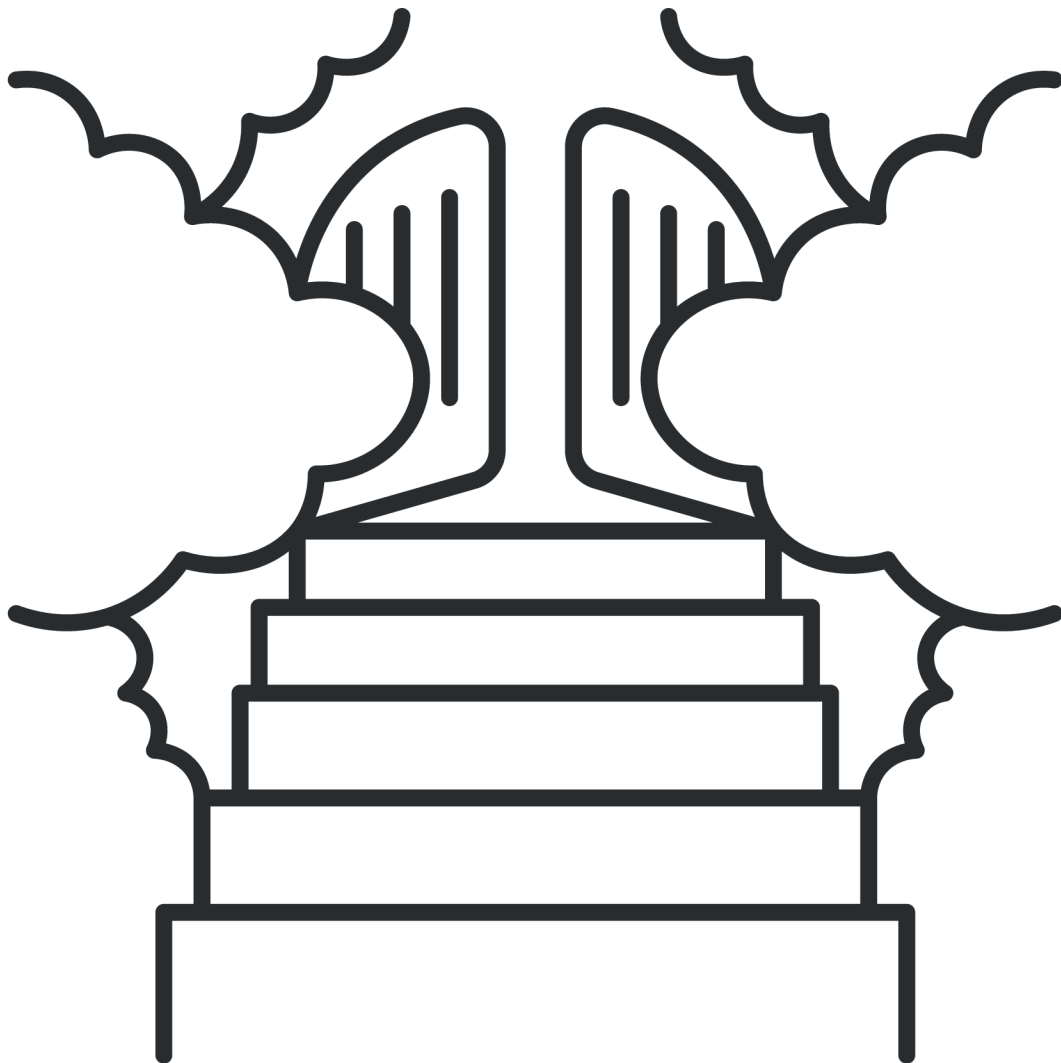


One thief made fun of
